STiNE Registration: Things to keep in mind

- Check rules of:
 - Participation
 - Admission and
 - Examination.
- Check registration context/module reference in STiNE

STiNE Registration periods

- Registration period:
 - 06.10. - 09.10.2025, 4 pm

- Changes and corrections period :
 - 13.10. – 23.10.2025, 1 pm
 - Only for leftover capacity!
 - First come, first serve
 - Therefore: Always register within the first period if possible, since you might find capacity filled in the modules of your choice during in the correction period!

STiNE troubleshooting

Registration and re-registration of exam dates

- By registration for the course (module with examination) you are automatically registered for the examination.
- You can only deregister until the end of the changes and corrections period
- No participation in the exam without registration

Exam Re-takes

- Maximum of **3** tries (2 re-takes) for each module.
 - Failing a exam three times means withdrawal from the program!
 - This applies to any module!
 - Final thesis only 1 re-take!
 - In case of illness, hand in a **doctor's notice** immediately. Find Form [here](#). Otherwise, missing a registered exam will be counted as failed attempt!

Recognition - Crediting of previous courses

- You can request crediting of courses, if...
 - ... these courses correspond to modules that exist in your Master's program
 - ... you have not yet conducted the exam of the corresponding module (and have no binding exam registration)
 - No recognition of BA-Modules

Crediting of courses

Process:

- Step 1: **Decide** which modules you want to be credited
Contact the program advisor [Prof. Dr. rer. nat. habil. Ralf Möller](#) or [PD Dr. rer. nat. habil. Özgür L. Özçep](#)
Apart from your signature a PDF summary of your request, you need a Transcript of Records (or similar proof of your previous studies) and module descriptions (“module handbook”, “syllabus” or similar). [Find Form here.](#)
- Step 2: Your program advisor will inform the Academic Office.
- Step 3: **Wait for decision** of the Head Examination Board

Part-time study

- **There is the chance of part-time study, ...**
- ... regular *professional work* of more than 15h per week (Proof: e.g. Certificate of employer)
- ... necessary *care* for children (below age 18) or other family member in need of care (Proof: e.g. birth certificate, etc.)
- ... *disability or other chronic disease* that affect the ability to study such that full-time study is impossible (Proof: e.g. medical certificate)

Part-time study

- Purpose: **Workload** reduced from 30 ECTS to 15 ECTS per semester
 - Advantage: Adjustment of regular study time. You have more than 4 semesters to study.
 - Disadvantage: Can have effects on BAföG, grants, child benefits, visa agreements...
- Note: Final thesis has to be conducted in full time (6 months, approx. 40 hours per week), even if you are a part-time student
